## For An Act To Be Entitled

```
AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-15-304(a) TO Clarify the law that a woman who as a result of her pregnancy meets the definition of a "person WITH A DISABILITY" MAY OBTAIN A TEMPORARY SPECIAL CERTIFICATE FOR DISABLED PARKING PRIVILEGES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
```


## Subtitle

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE LAW THAT A WOMAN WHO AS A RESULT OF HER PREGNANCY MEETS THE DEFINITION OF A "PERSON WITH A DI SABILITY" MAY OBTAIN TEMPORARY DI SABLED PARKING PRIVILEGES.

```
BE IT ENACTED BY the GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF the State OF ARKANSAS:
```

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-15-304(a) is amended to read as follows:
(a) A person with a disability, which, as determined by a licensed physician is temporary in nature as opposed to permanent, may apply to the office for a temporary person with a disability special certificate, and, upon request, one (1) additional temporary special certificate. A woman who as a result of her pregnancy in the third trimester meets the definition of "person with a disability", as determined by a licensed physician, shall be eligible to apply for the temporary "person with a disability" special certificate. Provided further, that a person to whom has been issued a special license plate or a special certificate may obtain one (1) temporary special certificate. The intent herein being to provide any person with a

disability at least one (1), but not more than two (2), special indicia authorizing the use of parking spaces reserved exclusively for persons with disabilities.
