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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-507(b), concerning the list of mandated
22 reporters, is amended to read as follows:

23 (b) When any physician, surgeon, coroner, dentist, osteopath, resident
24 intern, licensed nurse, medical personnel who may be engaged in admission,
25 examination, care, or treatment of persons, teacher, school official, school
26 counselor, social worker, family service worker, day care center worker, or
27 any other child or foster care worker, mental health professional, peace
28 officer, law enforcement official, prosecuting attorney, domestic abuse
29 advocate, or judge has reasonable cause to suspect that a child has been
30 subjected to child maltreatment, or that a child has died as a result of
31 child maltreatment, or who observes a child being subjected to conditions or
32 circumstances which would reasonably result in child maltreatment, he shall
33 immediately notify the child abuse hotline.
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
