21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-51-1406, concerning warning by motorists of
24 approach, is repealed.

25 ~~27-51-1406. Warning by motorists to persons and animals on highway.~~
26 ~~Upon approaching a person walking upon or along a public highway, or a horse~~
27 ~~or other draft animal being ridden, led, or driven thereon, the operator of a~~
28 ~~motor vehicle or motor bicycle shall give reasonable warning of his approach~~
29 ~~and use every reasonable precaution to avoid injuring the persons or~~
30 ~~frightening the horses or other draft animals.~~

32 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-51-1407, concerning stopping for frightened
33 horses, is repealed.

35 ~~(a) Whenever it shall appear that any horse ridden or driven by any~~
36 ~~person upon any streets, roads, and highways is about to become frightened by~~

1 ~~the approach of any motor vehicle, it shall be the duty of the person driving~~
2 ~~or conducting the motor vehicle to cause it to come to a full stop until the~~
3 ~~horse shall have passed and, if necessary, assist in preventing an accident.~~

4 ~~(b) Any person convicted of violating this section shall be fined in~~
5 ~~any sum not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200).~~
