Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-51-1406, concerning warning by motorists of approach, is repealed.
27.51.1406. Warning by motorists to persons and animals on highway. Upon approaching a person walking upon or along a public highway, or a horse or other draft animal being ridden, led, or driven thereon, the operator of a motor vehicle or motor bicycle shall give reasonable warning of his approach
and use every reasonable precaution to avoid injuring the persons or
frightening the horses or other draft animals.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-51-1407, concerning stopping for frightened horses, is repealed.
27.51.1407. Stopping for frightened horses.
(a) Whenever it shall appear that any horse ridden or driven by any person upon any streets, roads, and highways is about to become frightened by

```
the approach of any motor vehicle, it shall be the duty of the person driving
or conducting the motor vehicle to cause it to come to a full stop until the
horse shall have passed and, if necessary, assist in preventing an accident._
    (b) Any person convicted of violating this section shall be fined in
any sum not to exceed two hundred dollars ($200).
```
