27	approaching a stop intersection indicated by a stop sign shall stop as		
28	required by § 27-51-601, and after having stopped, shall yield the right-of-		
29	way to any vehicle which has entered the intersection from another highway or		
30	which is approaching so closely on the highway as to constitute an immediate		
31	hazard. The driver having so yielded may proceed, and the drivers of all other		
32	vehicles approaching the intersection shall yield the right-of-way to the		
33	vehi cl e so proceedi ng.		
34	(c)(1) The driver of a vehicle or the motorman of a streetcar		
35	approaching a yield sigr	n shall, in obedience to such si	gn, slow down to a

35 approaching a yield sign shall, in obedience to such sign, slow down to a 36 speed reasonable for the existing conditions, or shall stop if necessary as provided in § 27-51-601, and shall yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian legally crossing the roadway on which he is driving. The driver shall also yield to any vehicle in the intersection or approaching on another highway so closely as to constitute an immediate hazard. A driver having so yielded may proceed, and the drivers of all other vehicles approaching the intersection shall yield to the vehicle so proceeding.

7 (2) If a driver is involved in a collision with a pedestrian in a
8 crosswalk or a vehicle in the intersection after driving past a yield sign

14 (a) The driver of a vehicle shall not overtake and pass upon the left

15 nor drive upon the left side of any streetcar proceeding in the same

16 direction, whether the streetcar is actually in motion or temporarily at rest, 17 except:

(1) When so directed by a police officer;

19 (2) When upon a one-way street; or-

20 (3) When upon a street where the tracks are so located as to
 21 prevent compliance with this section.

22 (b) The driver of any vehicle, when permitted to overtake and pass upon

23 the left of a streetcar which has stopped for the purpose of receiving or

24 discharging any passenger, shall reduce speed and may proceed only upon

25 exercising due caution for pedestrians and shall accord pedestrians the right-

26 of-way when required by other sections of this chapter.

29The driver of a vehicle overtaking upon the right any streetcar stopped30or about to stop for the purpose of receiving or discharging any passenger

31 shall stop the vehicle at least five feet (5') to the rear of the nearest

33 passengers have boarded the car or, upon alighting, have reached a place of

Obstruction to driver's view or driving mechanism 23 prohibited. 24 (a) No person shall drive a vehicle when it is so loaded, or when there 25 are in the front seat a number of persons, exceeding three (3), as to obstruct 26 the view of the driver to the front or sides of the vehicle so as to interfere 27 with the driver's control over the driving mechanism of the vehicle. 28 No passenger in a vehicle or streetcar shall ride in such position (b) 29 as to interfere with the driver's or motorman's view ahead or to the sides or 30 to interfere with his control over the driving mechanism of the vehicle or 31 streetcar. 32 33 34 35 36

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
