Arkansas Code 6-17-106(a), pertaining to insult or abuse of 27 28 a teacher, is amended to read as follows: 29 (a)(1) Any person who shall abuse or insult a public school teacher while that teacher is performing normal and regular or assigned school 30 31 responsibilities It is unlawful, during regular school hours, and in a place 32 where a public school employee is required to be in the course of his or her 33 duties, for any person to address a public school employee using language which, in its common acceptation, is calculated to: 34 35 (A) Cause a breach of the peace; (B) Materially and substantially interfere with the 36

2	(C) Arouse the person to whom it is addressed to anger, to
3	the extent likely to cause imminent retaliation.
4	(2) A person who violates this section shall be guilty of a
5	misdemeanor and upon conviction be liable for a fine of not less than one
6	hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than one thousand five hundred dollars
7	(\$1, 500).
