15 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 25-4-110  
16 (c) TO REQUIRE STATE AGENCIES TO DEVELOP

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-4-110(c), concerning agency technology  
24 plans, is amended to read as follows:

25 (c) (1) Each agency shall develop a biennial information technology  
26 plan that establishes agency goals, ~~and objectives,~~ and policies regarding  
27 the development and use of information technology. Each agency shall  
28 specifically include a policy regarding the use of the Internet. Plans may  
29 be updated by agencies in a timely manner to remain current and must  
30 accommodate changes in the evolving state information technology plan and  
31 standards.

32 (2) A statement of the agency's policy regarding the use of the  
33 internet shall include:

34 (A) The penalties for violations of the agency's Internet  
35 policy;

36 (B) The number of employees and computers which have

1 access to the Internet and the percentage of those employees and computers to  
2 the total number of employees and computers;

3 (C) The needs of the agency and how it relates to the use  
4 of the Internet; and

5 (D) The responsibilities of the agency's employees as it  
6 relates to the efficient and responsible use of the Internet.
