19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-9-106(b) is amended to read as follows:

22 (b) In addition to the requirements of subsection (a) of this section
23 and § 12-9-104(7), the commission, by rules and regulations, shall fix such
24 other qualifications as it deems necessary. However, no person who pleads or
25 is found guilty of a felony shall be eligible to be appointed or certified as
26 a law enforcement officer unless the person has received a pardon and has
27 received the approval of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards
28 and Training.
