15 WHILE THE SCHOOL BUS IS MOVING.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. (a) The driver of a school bus shall not operate the  
21 school bus until every passenger is seated.

22 (b) As used in this section, "school bus" shall mean any vehicle being  
23 used to convey children to and from school, and which is marked in both front  
24 and rear with the words "SCHOOL BUS", in plain lettering, readable in  
25 daylight at a distance of at least two hundred feet (200') from such vehicle.

26 (c) The superintendent of each public school in this state shall be  
27 responsible for ensuring that no school bus is scheduled to transport more  
28 students than can be reasonably seated in the school bus.

29 (d) Any superintendent who knowingly violates subsection (c) of this  
30 act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined not  
31 less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100).
