## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 1-5-106, CONCERNING  
MEMORIAL DAYS IN ARKANSAS, TO ADD DECEMBER 19 OF  
EACH YEAR AS SENATOR HATTIE W. CARAWAY DAY; AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO NAME DECEMBER 19 OF EACH YEAR AS  
SENATOR HATTIE W. CARAWAY DAY IN  
ARKANSAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 1-5-106 is amended to read as follows:  
1-5-106. Memorial days generally.

The following days shall not be legal holidays but shall be memorial  
days to be commemorated by the issuance of appropriate proclamations by the  
Governor:

- (1) General Douglas MacArthur Day - January 26th;
- (2) Abraham Lincoln's Birthday - February 12th;
- (3) Arkansas Teachers' Day - First Tuesday in March;
- (4) Arbor Day - Third Monday in March;
- ~~(4)~~(5) Patriots' Day - April 19th;
- ~~(5)~~(6) Arkansas Bird Day - April 26th;
- ~~(6)~~(7) Good Friday - Friday preceding Easter;
- ~~(7)~~(8) Jefferson Davis' Birthday - June 3rd;
- ~~(8)~~(9) Columbus Day - October 12th;

~~(9) Arbor Day — Third Monday in March~~

(10) Senator Hattie W. Caraway Day - December 19.
