6	counties, out of funds appropriated by the respective quorum courts of the		
7	counties for such purposes.		
8	(5) There shall be provided for the judge of the circuit		
9	judgeship created by this subsection (e) a court reporter and a trial court		
10	administrative assistant whose salaries shall be fixed and paid in the manner		
11	provided by law for court reporters and trial court administrative assistants		
12	of the circuit courts of this state.

14	SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE</u> . It is found and determined by the		
15	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the caseload of the Second		
16	<u>Judicial District necessitates the appointment of an additional circuit</u>		
17	judge. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being		
18	immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and		
19	safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor.		
20	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become		
21	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor		
22	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
23	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides		
24	the veto.
