21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-10-317, related to operations of 911  
24 public safety communications centers, is amended by adding an additional  
25 subsection to read as follows:

26 (c)(1) Service providers shall provide digital copies of addresses  
27 semi-annually, or as requested, to operating agencies for the purposes of  
28 ensuring addresses used for enhanced 911 operations are correct and  
29 consistent with legal addresses in use in the communities served.

30 (2) The subscriber provided information may be used for the  
31 purpose of development of address databases for use by the operating  
32 agencies, but shall not be provided to any other entity for any other  
33 purpose.
