18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GEN	ERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF	ARKANSAS:

20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-35-208(b), concerning the Length of		
21	vehicles on the highways in Arkansas, is amended to read as follows:		
22	(b) No bus operated on the highways of this state shall have an		
23	overall length in excess	of forty feet (40') forty-fi	ve feet (45').
24			
25	SECTION 2. Arkans	as Code 27-35-208(c), concern	ning the length of
26	vehicles on the highways	in Arkansas, is amended to r	read as follows:
27	(c)(1)(A) No semi	trailer or trailer operated o	on the highways of this
28	state in a truck tractor-semitrailer combination or a truck tractor-trailer		
29	combination shall have an overall length, unladen or with load, greater than		
30	those lengths that were in actual and lawful use in this state on December 1,		
31	1982.		
32	(B) I	ne state shall not establish	or enforce any
33	regulation which imposes a semitrailer or trailer length limitation of less		
34	than forty eight feet (48') on a semitrailer or trailer unit operating in		
35	combination with a truck tractor unit. No semitrailer, pole trailer, or		
36	trailer operated on the highways of this state shall have an overall length

1	unladen or laden, including any rear overhang, in excess of fifty-three feet		
2	six inches (53' 6") when operating in combination with a tuck or truck		
3	tractor.		
4	(2)(A) No semitrailer or trailer operated on the highways of		
5	this state in a truck tractor-semitrailer-trailer combination shall have an		
6	overall length, unladen or with load, in excess of twenty-eight feet (28').		
7	(B) Existing semitrailers or trailers of twenty-eight		
8	feet, six inches (28' 6") that were in actual and lawful use on December 1,		
9	1982, shall not be prohibited.		
10	(3) The length limitations described in this subsection (c)		
11	shall be exclusive of coupling devices, energy conservation devices, and		
12	safety devices as provided by federal regulations.
