## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 6, CHAPTER 17  
11 TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL SUBCHAPTER 21 TO ESTABLISH  
12 THE CLASSIFIED SCHOOL EMPLOYEE MINIMUM SALARY  
13 ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE CLASSIFIED  
17 SCHOOL EMPLOYEE MINIMUM SALARY ACT.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, is amended to add an  
24 additional subchapter to read as follows:

25 Subchapter 21 - Classified School Employee Minimum Salary Act  
26

27 6-17-2101. Title.

28 This subchapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Classified  
29 School Employee Minimum Salary Act."  
30

31 6-17-2102. Definitions.

32 As used in this subchapter, unless the context otherwise requires:

33 (1) "Classified employee" means any employee of a public school  
34 district in Arkansas who performs work for the district and who is not  
35 required to hold a valid teaching license issued by the State Board of  
36 Education as a condition of employment;

2 (2) "Full-time classified employee" means any classified employee who  
3 works twenty (20) or more hours per week for the public school district.

5 6-17-2103. Minimum salary.

6 (a) A full-time classified employee shall not receive an hourly rate  
7 of compensation less than six dollars and twenty five cents (\$6.25) per hour.

8 (b) No classified employee's hourly rate of compensation shall be  
9 reduced as a result of this subchapter.

10

11 6-17-2104. Rules and regulations.

12 The State Board of Education is authorized to promulgate rules and  
13 regulations to establish a method of determining whether a classified  
14 employee shall be considered to work twenty (20) or more hours per week.
