## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROTECT COLLEGE STUDENTS FROM UNFAIR
PRICING POLICIES BY CAMPUS BOOKSTORES THAT
REPURCHASE USED BOOKS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

THE BOOK BUY BACK PROTECTION ACT OF 2001.

```
BE IT ENACTED by THE GENERAL ASSEmBly OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
```

SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Book Buy Back Protection Act of 2001".

SECTION 2. (a) Bookstores located on a campus of a state-supported post-secondary educational institution shall pay no ess than fifty percent ( $50 \%$ ) of the original purchase price or sixty-five ( $65 \%$ ) percent of the retail price to be charged by the bookstore when reselling the book in the next semester.
(b) No state funds or book vouchers derived from student financial aid programs or an appropriation of the institutions operating budget may be used at a campus bookstore that violates this act.
(c) The Department of Higher Education shall develop procedures and
guidelines, which include random checking of repurchasing practices of
bookstores, to insure that students, institutions, and bookstores are not
violating provisions of this act.
(d) This act shall not apply to the repurchase of textbook editions that will not be used at the institution in either of the upcoming two (2)

## semesters.

(e) The Higher Education Coordinating Board shall promulgate regulations as necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
