24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Intent. It is recognized by the Arkansas General Assembly
27 that the Safe Drinking Water Act of 1996, and amendments, as enacted by the
28 United States Congress, appropriates funds to the Administrator of the
29 Environmental Protection Agency which in turn are to be granted to the State
30 for the purpose of providing financial reimbursement for costs of training
31 and certifying operators of water systems serving communities with
32 populations of 3,300 or less. It is further recognized that the State of
33 Arkansas should identify those organizations which shall be responsible for
34 providing of water system operator training and certification and which shall
35 qualify for financial reimbursement of training and certification costs.
