19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-60-120(a), concerning the interception and
22 recording of phone calls, is amended to read as follows:

23 (a) It shall be unlawful for a person to intercept a wire, oral, or
24 telephonic communication, defined as communications that utilize the
25 electromagnetic spectrum frequencies of forty-six to ~~forty-nine megahertz~~
26 ~~(46-49 mghz.)~~ nine hundred megahertz (46 - 900 mghz.) generally used by
27 cordless telephone technology and eight hundred forty to eight hundred eighty
28 megahertz (840-880 mghz.) generally used by cellular telephone technology,
29 and to record or possess a recording of such communication unless such a
30 person is a party to the communication or one (1) of the parties to the
31 communication has given prior consent to such interception and recording.
