Arkansas Code 11-9-113 is amended to read as follows: 20 21 11-9-113. Mental injury or illness. 22 (a)(1) A mental injury or illness is not a compensable injury unless 23 it is caused by physical injury to the employee's body, and shall not be 24 considered an injury arising out of and in the course of employment er and 25 compensable unless it is demonstrated by a preponderance of the evidence; 26 provided, however, that this physical injury limitation shall not apply to 27 any victim of a crime of violence. (2) No mental injury or illness under this section shall be 28 29 compensable unless it is also diagnosed by a licensed psychiatrist or psychologist and unless the diagnosis of the condition meets the criteria 30 31 established in the most current issue of the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders. 32 33 (b)(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, where a claim is by reason of mental injury or illness, the employee shall be limited 34 35 to twenty-six (26) weeks of disability benefits injury shall be treated as 36 any other compensable injury.

2	illness within a period of one (1) year <u>from the last time compensation was</u>
3	paid or two (2) years from the date of injury, compensation shall be paid the
4	dependents as provided in other death cases under this chapter.
5	(B) Death directly or indirectly related to the mental
6	injury or illness occurring one (1) year or more from the incident resulting
7	in the mental injury or illness shall not be a compensable injury.
