22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this act, no public
25 water system in Arkansas supplying drinking water to a political subdivision
26 shall add fluoridation to the water until a majority of the qualified
27 electors in the political subdivision have approved the question of
28 fluoridating the water supplies within that political subdivision.

29 (b) Political subdivision as used in subsection (a) of this section
30 means a county or a city of the first class, city of the second class or an
31 incorporated town.

32 (c) Upon a request by the public water system, the governing body of
33 the political subdivision shall place the question on fluoridating water in
34 the jurisdiction on the ballot at the next general election.
