17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-2-102 is amended to read as follows:*  
20 *7-2-102. First Congressional District.*

21 *The First Congressional District shall be composed of the counties of:*  
22 *Arkansas, Clay, Cleburne, Craighead, Crittenden, Cross, Desha, Fulton,*  
23 *Greene, Independence, Izard, Jackson, Jefferson, Lawrence, Lee, ~~Lonoke,~~*  
24 *Mississippi, Monroe, Phillips, Prairie, Poinsett, Randolph, St. Francis,*  
25 *~~Searcy,~~ Sharp, Stone, and Woodruff; and the qualified electors residing*  
26 *therein shall elect one (1) member of the House of Representatives of the*  
27 *United States.*

29 *SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 7-2-103 is amended to read as follows:*  
30 *7-2-103. Second Congressional District.*

31 *The Second Congressional District shall be composed of the counties of:*  
32 *Conway, Faulkner, Lonoke, ~~Perry,~~ Pope, Pulaski, ~~Saline,~~ Searcy, Van Buren,*  
33 *and ~~White,~~ ~~and~~ ~~Yell~~; and the qualified electors residing therein shall elect*  
34 *one (1) member of the House of Representatives of the United States.*
