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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. (a) On and after September 1, 2001, every martial arts
22 instructor of minor children, and every owner or operator of a place of
23 business which instructs minor children in martial arts shall be required to
24 apply to the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police
25 for a state and national criminal background check, to be conducted by the
26 Federal Bureau of Investigation.

27 (b) The check shall conform to the applicable federal standards and
28 shall include the taking of fingerprints.

29 (c) The applicant shall sign a release of information and shall be
30 responsible to the Department of Arkansas State Police for the payment of any
31 fee associated with the criminal background check.

32 (d) Upon completion of the criminal background check, the
33 Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police shall
34 forward all information obtained concerning the applicant to the local chief
35 of police and county sheriff of the person's place of business.

36 (e) At the conclusion of any background check required by this

1 section, the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police
2 shall promptly destroy the fingerprint card of the applicant.
