For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF CARE FOR
ELDERCHOICES CLIENTS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH
DISABILITIES BY PROHIBITING PRIVATE FOR-PROFIT
AND PRIVATE NON-PROFIT AGENCIES FROM USING IN-
HOME AIDES UNDER INDIVIDUAL OR TEMPORARY
CONTRACTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT PRIVATE ELDERCHOICES
AND DISABILITY CARE AGENCIES FROM USING
IN-HOME AIDES UNDER INDIVIDUAL OR
TEMPORARY CONTRACTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. No entity which provides services in the home of
individuals and who is designated by the Division of Aging and Adult Services
of the Department of Human Services as an ElderChoices provider, nor any
employment agency which hires or procures, on behalf of another entity or
organization, individuals who provide services in the home and are designated
by the division as ElderChoices providers, whether or not the entity has
applied for or possesses any license or certification necessary for
operation, shall employ in-home aides under individual or temporary
contracts.
