18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. (a) A person commits aggravated assault by vehicle if the
21 person negligently causes serious bodily injury to another person as a result
22 of operating a vehicle, an aircraft, or a watercraft:

23 (1) While intoxicated as defined by Arkansas Code 5-65-102; or

24 (2) If at that time there is an alcohol concentration of eight-
25 hundredths (0.08) or more in the person's breath or blood based upon the
26 definition of breath, blood and urine concentration in Arkansas Code 5-65-
27 204.

28 (b) As used in this section, "serious bodily injury" means any bodily
29 injury which creates a substantial risk of death or which causes serious,
30 permanent disfigurement or protracted loss or impairment of the function of
31 any bodily member or organ.

32 (c) Aggravated assault by vehicle is a Class D felony.
