AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 6, CHAPTER 51, SUBCHAPTER 6, TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL SECTION TO PRESCRIBE THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR NONCOMMERCIAL DRIVER TRAINING INSTRUCTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR NONCOMMERCIAL DRIVER TRAINING INSTRUCTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 51, Subchapter 6, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-51-622. Noncommercial driver training instruction.

(a) Any person teaching or instructing persons under the age of eighteen (18) to drive a noncommercial motor vehicle shall offer the minimum amount of driver training to those student-drivers as prescribed by this section.

(b) The minimum requirements for classroom driver training instruction for noncommercial motor vehicles shall consist of:

(1) Thirty (30) hours or more of classroom instruction on driving techniques and rules of the road in Arkansas, including six (6) hours of classroom instruction on traffic law changes that have occurred within the last ten (10) years; and

(2) Ten (10) hours of behind-the-wheel driving experience.

1 (c) The minimum requirements of correspondence programs for driver
2 training instruction for noncommercial motor vehicles shall consist of:

3 (1) A maximum of twenty-eight (28) hours of correspondence work;

4 (2) A minimum of two (2) hours or more of classroom instruction
5 on driving techniques and rules of the road in Arkansas; and

6 (3) Ten (10) hours of behind-the-wheel driving experience.

7 (d)(1) The State Board of Private Career Education may promulgate
8 reasonable rules and regulations to implement, enforce, and administer this
9 section.

10 (2) The board's regulations shall be issued in accordance with
11 the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, beginning at § 25-15-201.
