22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-38-304(f) concerning applications for
25 licensure as a master or journeyman plumber, is amended to read as follows:

26 (f) The Committee of Plumbing Examiners ~~shall~~ may approve an applicant
27 for examination who is not currently licensed in another state or its
28 political subdivision or who has no plumber licensing background, provided
29 the applicant shows proof of experience as a plumber in accordance with
30 subsection (d) of this section. The proof of experience may be in the form
31 of records, affidavits, or bona fide evidence from licensing agencies, former
32 employers, or from persons who can attest to the applicant's work background
33 as a plumber.
