20 WHEREAS, the position of constable is established in the Constitution of
21 Arkansas without any guidance as to the required duties of the constable; and
22

23 WHEREAS, it is necessary that the General Assembly review the position
24 of constable and determine if additional training requirements would be
25 valuable to the citizens of Arkansas; and
26

27 WHEREAS, constables serve an important part in law enforcement and it
28 would be beneficial to look at redefining the position and duties.

30 NOW THEREFORE,

31 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
32 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

34 That the House and Senate Interim Committees on State Agencies and
35 Governmental Affairs are requested to study the duties, powers, and training
36 of constables.
