20	WHEREAS, the position of constable is established in the Constitution of
21	Arkansas without any guidance as to the required duties of the constable; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, it is necessary that the General Assembly review the position
24 25	of constable and determine if additional training requirements would be
25 26	valuable to the citizens of Arkansas; and
20	WHEREAS, constables serve an important part in law enforcement and it
28	would be beneficial to look at redefining the position and duties.
