15	TO IMPLEMENT AND TEACH THE EDDIE EAGLE
16	ELEMENTARY GUN SAFETY EDUCATION PROGRAM.

19	WHEREAS, teaching children how to act safely around firearms is a
20	critical step in the effort to reduce the number of accidents related to
21	firearms that involve children; and
22	WHEREAS, most accidents involving firearms are the result of a violation
23	of the basic safety rules of firearm use; and
24	WHEREAS, many of these tragic accidents could be prevented by providing
25	the opportunity for broad based basic firearms safety training and education
26	programs in our schools, communities and homes; and
27	WHEREAS, the Eddie Eagle Elementary Gun Safety Education Program teaches
28	the fundamentals of firearm safety to children through a simple and clear
29	lifesaving message that children are taught to remember and act upon: "If you
30	see a gun: STOP! DON'T TOUCH. LEAVE THE AREA. TELL AN ADULT."; and
31	WHEREAS, the Eddie Eagle Elementary Gun Safety Education Program is a
32	nationally recognized firearms safety program that has reached more than six
33	million children since 1988; and
34	WHEREAS, participating children receive certificates of merit and
35	stickers and posters of Eddie Eagle, the program's lovable feathered mascot,
36	in addition to invaluable safety training that could save a life

2	NOW THEREFORE,
3	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
4	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
5	THAT the Arkansas General Assembly encourages civic and community
6	service organizations which are concerned about the safety and well-being of
7	the children of this state to help provide funding for the implementation of
8	the Eddie Eagle Elementary Gun Safety Education Program in the public schools.
9	
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arkansas General Assembly encourages the
11	Department of Education to promote the use of the Eddie Eagle Elementary Gun
12	Safety Education Program in the public schools to help prevent accidents
13	related to firearms that involve children.
14	
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arkansas General Assembly commends the
16	National Rifle Association of America for developing the Eddie Eagle
17	Elementary Gun Safety Education Program and making it available for use in the
18	public schools of this state.

20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Clerk of the House of
21	Representatives prepare and transmit a copy of this resolution to the Director
22	of the Department of Education and the Executive Vice President of the
23	National Rifle Association of America.
