22	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
23	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

25	That the Arkansas General Assembly urges the Arkansas Supreme Court to
26	revise the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure to:
27	(1) Allow a search warrant to be executed between the hours of 8
28	p.m. and 6 a.m. upon a finding by the issuing judicial officer that there is
29	a reasonable cause to believe that controlled substances are being
30	manufactured; and
31	(2) Declare that there is reasonable cause for the issuance of a
32	search warrant if a reasonably well trained law enforcement officer could, in
33	good faith, conclude from chemical odor that methamphetamine is being
34	manufactured.
