17 REQUESTING THAT THE HOUSE AND SENATE
18 INTERIM COMMITTEES ON EDUCATION CONDUCT
19 AN INTERIM STUDY TO DETERMINE THE IMPACT
20 OF NON-INSTRUCTIONAL DUTIES PLACED ON
21 MEMBERS OF THE TEACHING PROFESSION.

23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
24 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

26 That the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education are requested
27 to conduct an interim study to determine the effects of non-instructional
28 obligations placed on members of the teaching profession and the impact that
29 restricting the non-instructional obligations of teachers would have on the
30 school district, on the profession, and on the students. The impact on
31 restricting duties on elementary school, middle school and high school
32 teachers should be considered separately.

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committees are requested to make
35 recommendations in the form of proposed legislation to the Eighty-Fourth
36 General Assembly of Arkansas no later than January, 2003.
