22	shall not exceed sixty days in duration, unless extended by a vote of two-
23	thirds of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly; and

26	session will be necessary for the completion of the business of this session;

29	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
30	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

32	That the regular session of the Eighty-third General Assembly of the
33	State of Arkansas is hereby extended through the close of business in each
34 25	house on Friday, April 6, 2001, at which time the regular session shall be
35	adjourned sine die unless it is determined that a further extension is
36	necessary to complete the business of the session.
