23 WHEREAS, Section 17 of Article V of the Constitution of the State of  
24 Arkansas provides that the regular biennial session of the General Assembly  
25 shall not exceed sixty days in duration, unless extended by a vote of two-  
26 thirds of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly; and

28 WHEREAS, it now appears that a further extension of this regular  
29 session will be necessary for the completion of the business of this session;

31 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-  
32 THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING  
33 THEREIN:

35 That the regular session of the Eighty-third General Assembly of the  
36 State of Arkansas is hereby extended through the close of business in each

house on Friday, April 13, 2001, at which time the regular session shall be  
adjourned sine die unless it is determined that a further extension is  
necessary to complete the business of the session.
