MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the
Constituti on of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the
electors of the state for approval or rejection at the next general election
for Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting
thereon at such election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part
of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:
SECTION 1. Section 3 of Amendment 50 to the Constitution of Arkans is amended to read as follows:
§3. Numbering and recording of ballots. Disclosure of vote prohibited Exception Perforated Ballots.
In elections by ballot every no ballot shall be numbered in the order in which it is received, the number shall be recorded by the election officers on the list of voters opposite the name of the elector who presents

## the ballot, and the election officers shall be sworn or affirmed not to

 disclose how any elector voted unless required to do so as witnesses in a judicial proceeding or a proceeding to contest an election separated into a ballot and a ballot stub, and only the ballot shall be deposited into the ballot box.
