WHEREAS, under Article V of the Constitution of the United States, amendments to the federal Constitution may be proposed by the Congress whenever two thirds (2/3) of both Houses deem it necessary, or upon the application of the legislatures of two-thirds (2/3) of the several states the Congress shall call a Convention for the purpose of proposing amendments. We believe such action vital;
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
THAT this body proposes to the Congress of the United States that procedures be instituted in the Congress to add a new article to the Constitution of the United States, and that the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas request the Congress to prepare and submit to the several states an amendment to the Constitution of the United States, to limit the terms of Representatives and Senators serving in the United States Congress; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be sent by the Secretary of State to the Arkansas Congressional Delegation; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of State of the State of Arkansas is directed to send copies of this Joint Resolution to the Secretary of State and presiding officers of both Houses of the Legislature of each of the other states of the Union, the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, Washington, D.C., and the Secretary of the United States Senate, Washington, D.C.
