24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
25 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 That the House Interim Committee on Agriculture and Economic
28 Development and the Senate Interim Committee on Agriculture, Economic and
29 Industrial Development study the feasibility of establishing empowerment
30 zones throughout the state. Included in the study, the committees shall
31 examine:

32 (1) The areas to be considered, including but not limited to the
33 desired combination of retail, manufacturers, and residential zones within
34 the empowerment zone;

35 (2) The fiscal impact of tax exemptions for empowerment zones; and

36 (3) Whether any other states have attempted to implement this type of

1 legislation and the effect of the legislation.
