24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
25 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 That the House and Senate Interim Committees on Revenue and Taxation
28 study the feasibility of establishing empowerment zones throughout the state.
29 Included in the study, the committees shall examine:

30 (1) The areas to be considered, including but not limited to the
31 desired combination of retail, manufacturers, and residential zones within
32 the empowerment zone;

33 (2) The fiscal impact of tax exemptions for empowerment zones; and

34 (3) Whether any other states have attempted to implement this type of
35 legislation and the effect of the legislation.
