25 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL  
26 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
27

28 That the House and Senate Interim Committees on Judiciary are requested  
29 to conduct a study concerning long-term drug treatment of criminal offenders  
30 who are addicted to methamphetamine or crack cocaine.

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Community  
33 Punishment is requested to file a report with the committees by September 1,  
34 2001, concerning the department's programs to provide long-term drug  
35 treatment of criminal offenders who are addicted to methamphetamine or crack  
36 cocaine. The report should include:

- (1) A description of the drug treatment program and options used by the department;
- (2) A list of the facilities used in the treatment program;
- (3) The number of offenders in each facility who are participating in the long-term treatment program;
- (4) The number and categories of treatment staff utilized by the program;
- (5) The average length of treatment;
- (6) The recidivism rate; and
- (7) Any recommendations to improve the department's drug treatment of criminal offenders who are addicted to methamphetamine or crack cocaine.
