9 PROVIDING FOR AN INTERIM STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY
10 AND DESIRABILITY OF ABOLISHING OR REORGANIZING
11 THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD; TO STUDY

29 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
30 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

32 That the Joint Performance Review Committee is requested to make a
33 study of the feasibility and desirability of abolishing or reorganizing the
34 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board; to study the current liquor licensing laws
35 and procedures to determine their affect on competition including, but not
36 limited to, antitrust issues; and to study the feasibility and desirability

1 of establishing state owned and operated package stores, and the appropriate
2 role of liquor wholesalers.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Joint Performance Review Committee is
4 requested to authorize members of the House Rules Committee to participate in
5 the study.
