26 WHEREAS, a question has arisen regarding the residency of college
27 students for the purpose of voter qualification; and

29 WHEREAS, various state officials have issued conflicting opinions on
30 the issue,

32 NOW THEREFORE,

33 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
34 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

36 That the House and Senate Interim Education Committees and the House

1 and Senate Interim Committees on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs are
2 requested to jointly conduct an interim study to determine the appropriate
3 residency requirement for college students for purposes of voter
4 qualifications.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committees are requested to make
7 recommendations in the form of proposed legislation to the Eighty-Fourth
8 General Assembly of Arkansas no later than January, 2003.
