20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
21 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 That the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education are requested
24 to conduct an interim study of statewide extended-year schools. In conducting
25 the study, the committees are requested to consider:

- 26 (1) Academic achievement;
- 27 (2) College enrollment and entrance deadlines;
- 28 (3) Standardized statewide school calendar;
- 29 (4) Different calendar configurations;
- 30 (5) Number of student contact days;
- 31 (6) Number of staff development and inservice days and scheduling
32 considerations;
- 33 (7) Fiscal implications, such as increased operational costs;
- 34 (8) Salaries, savings, and other financial considerations;
- 35 (9) Effect on extracurricular activities;
- 36 (10) Effect on teachers attending summer school;

- 1 (11) Summer break;
- 2 (12) Breaks throughout the year;
- 3 (13) Enrichment/summer school opportunities for students; and
- 4 (14) Any other relevant considerations.
