24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
25 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 That the House and Senate Interim Committees on Judiciary are requested
28 to conduct an interim study concerning the adequacy of treatment programs and
29 facilities available for drug offenders, and the impact drug offenders are
30 having on the Department of Correction and the Department of Community
31 Punishment, and to recommend long-term plans to address any inadequacies
32 identified. The plan shall include, but shall not be limited to,
33 recommendations for improving the availability of drug treatment programs,
34 providing funding for those programs, and proposals to lessen the impact drug
35 offenders have on the Department of Correction and the Department of
36 Community Punishment.
