31 *WHEREAS, Joshua Luke Morris, a ten-year-old Springdale boy, was*
32 *involved in an automobile accident on February 17, 2001, which resulted in*
33 *serious injuries to himself, and minor injuries to his mother, Karen and his*
34 *nine-year-old sister, Hanna; and*

36 *WHEREAS, Little Rock Police Chief Ken Parker, Rogers respiratory*

1 *therapist Tom W. Gray, and nurse, Jolene Key, happened upon the accident and*
2 *stopped to provide assistance; and*

4 *WHEREAS, Luke had stopped breathing and Mr. Gray and Ms. Key provided*
5 *cardiopulmonary resuscitation to Luke until he again began breathing on his*
6 *own; and*

8 *WHEREAS, Chief Parker meanwhile provided aid and comfort to Luke's*
9 *mother and his sister until rescue workers and other professional aid*
10 *arrived; and*

12 *WHEREAS, Tom Gray, Ken Parker, and Jolene Key have displayed the very*
13 *best example of good Samaritans;*

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
18 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 courage in recovering from his injuries received in a car accident on
22 February 17, and commends Tom Gray, Ken Parker, and Jolene Key for providing
23 life saving measures, aid and comfort to Luke and his family.
