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28	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
29	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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31	That the House and Senate Interim Committee on Education are requested
32	to conduct an interim study to determine the effectiveness and timeliness of
33	the state's and the Department of Education's procedures to identify and
34	assist school districts in academic or fiscal distress; to determine if the
35	Department of Education's rules and regulations identifying and governing
36	districts in distress are sufficient to obtain the state's goal of improving

the education of students in the distressed districts; and to develop a plan to improve the current system, on or before August 1, 2002.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Department of Education is requested to review its rules and regulations identifying and governing districts in distress to determine if the current procedures are effective in identifying and assisting school districts in distress in a timely and effective manner. The Department of Education is further requested to provide to the House and Senate Interim Committees on Education a report on the department's review no later than May 1, 2002.
