Arkansas Code 12-12-211(c) is amended to read as follows: 23 24 (c)(1) An elected law enforcement officer of a political subdivision of 25 this state shall not be allowed access to information from the Arkansas Crime 26 Information Center unless either the elected law enforcement officer or a law 27 enforcement officer within his department has successfully completed the 28 preparatory program of police training required by the Arkansas Commission on 29 Law Enforcement Standards and Training for certification of law enforcement 30 offi cers. 31 (2) If the elected officer is a constable, and the constable has 32 received a minimum of one hundred twenty (120) hours of certified training 33 from the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, then the constable shall be allowed access to information from the Arkansas Crime 34 35 Information Center while in the performance of duties as a law enforcement 36 officer. However, to maintain this access each constable must complete at
