SECTION 6. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>FUND BALANCES.</u> (A) For all appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. _Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency

9 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the

10 <u>State requesting approval of the expenditures</u>. Such documentation shall

11 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall

12 <u>include the following</u>:

13 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such

14 <u>expenditures on the fund balance.</u>

15 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or

16 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.

17 <u>3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs</u>

18 <u>or one-time purchase of capitalized items.</u>

19 <u>4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not</u>

20 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent

21 <u>depletion of the fund balance.</u>

22 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and

23 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought

24 prior review by the Legislative Council.

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26 SECTION 7. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment for 27 28 services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in writing 29 to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the required legal 30 servi ces. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the requested legal 31 services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall determine that sufficient 32 personnel are not available to provide the requested legal services, the 33 Attorney General shall certify the same to the agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend monies appropriated for 34 35 Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if:

36 (1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such

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1 agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and

2 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the 3 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.

SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by 10 11 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 12 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 13 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures 14 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and 15 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 16 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 17 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 18 with in disbursement of said funds.

19

20 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 21 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 22 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 23 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 24 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 26 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 27 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 30 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 31 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the 32 33 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date 34 35 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper 36 administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
