

15 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 16 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. 17 Any unexpended balances of appropriation and funds authorized for Capital 18 Outlay in Section 2 of this Act on June 30, 2000 2002, shall be carried 19 forward and made available for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending 20 June 30, 2001 2003.

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## 22 <u>The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001</u> 23 through June 30, 2003.

25 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 26 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNI FORMS. 27 After seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the 28 29 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training shall be exempt from Arkansas Code 19-6-109(c) for the purpose of buying uniforms for students. 30 31 The amount spent for the purchase of uniforms in any one year shall be limited 32 to \$40,000. 33

1 SECTION 7. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all 2 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall 3 4 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to 5 6 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the 7 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. 8 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head 9 shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide 10 11 sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall include the 12 following: 13 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such expenditures on the fund balance. 14 15 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance. 16 17 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs 18 or one-time purchase of capitalized items. 19 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not 20 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent 21 depletion of the fund balance. 22 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and 23 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought 24 prior review by the Legislative Council. 25 26 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 27 28 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 29 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures 30 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and 31 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 32 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 33 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 34

36 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

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that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9 <u>SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General</u>

10 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

11 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the

12 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the

13 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the

14 <u>event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date</u>

15 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper

16 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an

17 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the

18 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
