BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

    SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-15-1004(e) is amended to read as follows:
    (e)(1)(A) No class of students shall be under the instruction of a
    substitute teacher who is not certified to teach the grade level or subject
matter of the class for more than thirty (30) consecutive school days in the
same class during a school year unless that teacher has a bachelor's degree
awarded by an accredited college or university or has been licensed to teach
by the State of Arkansas.
(B) This provision shall not apply to substitutes for
nondegreed vocational-technical teachers.
(2) If this requirement imposes an undue hardship on a school
district, the district may aply to the State Board of Education for a waiver.
(3) The board shall develop rules and regulations for granting a

waiver.
(4) Any school district granted a waiver from this requirement shall be identified in the Department of Education's annual school district report card.
(5) Any school district that obtains a waiver shall send written notice of the assignment to the parent or guardian of each student in the classroom no later than the $30 t h$ school day after the date of the assignment.
