Emergency Clause. It is found and determined by the Eighty-21 third General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that an additional monthly 22 benefit amount for Teacher Retirement retirees will help offset the increasing 23 cost of health insurance; and that the beginning of the state's fiscal year is 24 the most administratively advantageous time to implement a benefit increase 25 for the system. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this act 26 being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health 27 and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2001. 28 29 30 31 32 33

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
