- 5 (b) For each year ending June 30, the social security retirement test 6 to be considered shall be the test in effect for the calendar year beginning 7 the January 1 immediately preceding June 30. The retirant's earnings shall be 8 his or her remuneration for such employment for the year ending June 30.
- 9 (c) The Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System

- (d) Receiving remuneration as an employee from any private employer or

23 SECTION 2. [THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION COMMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED TO CODIFY THIS SECTION.] No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall 24 25 be implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement system's 26 unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year 27 amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be implemented by any publicly supported system which has unfunded actuarial 28 29 accrued liabilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years 30 until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than 31 the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24. 32 33 SECTION 3. Emergency Clause. It is found and determined by the Eighty-34 third General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that retirants are sometimes 35 needed by the Arkansas Department of Education and the public schools to 36 fulfill vital positions within the educational system of Arkansas; that

1	current retirement laws limit the amount of salaries which can be paid to
