9	entrusted to the superintendent.		
10	(f)(1) The superintendent shall have power to select and engage all		
11	employees of the institution at salaries fixed by the governing board,		
12	reporting the selections for approval to the board at the next regular meeting		
13	thereof.		
14	(2) The superintendent shall have the sole power to remove		
15	employees of the institution and may remove any employee at any time in his		
16	discretion for cause, but in case of removal for cause, he shall report the		
17	removal and the grounds therefor to the governing board.
